About Us

Act Out uses social issues theatre to address the most pressing and complex issues facing students of all ages today and encourages them to embrace and be involved in developing solutions.

Programs generally last 45 minutes and involve two to three actors who present highly volatile situations. At the heat of the moment a moderator freezes the action and engages the students in discussing the situation and solutions. The actors remain in character often challenging the students and providing their point of view. It provides a safe place for conversation and a way for students to really empathize, criticize, and resolve how they might react for positive outcomes.

ACT Out is a program of Claude McNeal Productions, which is a 501(c)3 non-profit theatre organization that *inspires and transforms lives and cultural organizations through the energizing power of theatre and theatre-related programming.*
