

# ACT Out - Funding Opportunities for Presentations



ACT Out does have a program partnership with Peace Learning Center that will allow for a limited number of free programs each school year (for IPS schools only), however, if those programs are unavailable, here are some other opportunities to fund our presentations:

- ✓ **EANS** (Emergency Assistance to Non-Public Schools). Claude McNeal Productions/ACT Out is listed an official vendor with the IDOE.
- ✓ **Title IV (A)** funds can support almost all arts related programming and ACT Out can be used in the focus areas of "Safe and Healthy Schools" or "Well-rounded Education"
- ✓ **Title IV (B)** funding for out-of-school time programs serving K-12 youth in high need, low performing areas. The 21st Century Community Learning Center (21st CCLC) program provides grants to local school districts and community learning centers for afterschool programs serving students in low-performing schools.
- ✓ **ESSER II or III** funds can use ACT Out to support needs tied to the pandemic (SEL, etc.) Anything approvable with Title Grants can also be approved with ESSER – However it must relate back to a need created from or because of the pandemic.
- ✓ **Grants** through school or community foundations
