An introduction to stories that captivate us, characters that mirror us, language that startles us – all by the playwright who was “not of an age, but for all time.”

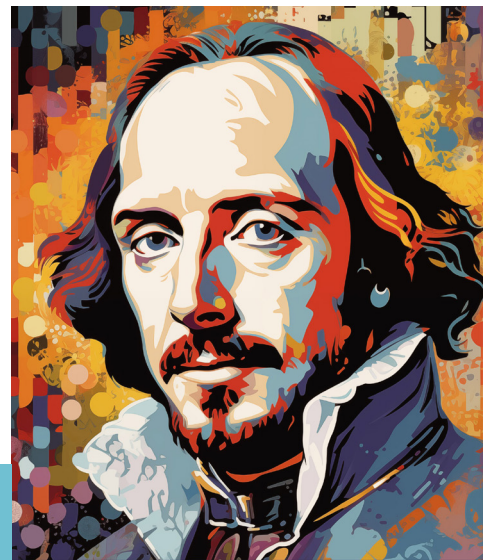
About the Show

In a fast-paced 65-minute live theater presentation, *Shakespeare Superstar* introduces students to immortal stories of loyalty, friendship, justice, power-hunger, love dilemmas, palace intrigue, family feuds, every-day triumphs and troubles, and the iconic, wonderfully complex characters and the choices they make. We meet the star-crossed lovers Romeo & Juliet, the angst-filled Hamlet, drama-queen Cleopatra, super villains Iago and Richard III, good kings and bad kings, faithful servants, sneaky companions, witches, fairies, magicians and more. There's even a 'crash course' in iambic pentameter. Students are quickly immersed as highlights from Shakespeare's classics display universal dilemmas of life, love, loyalty, morality, mortality, power, justice, and even the silliness and child-like wonders of our humanity.

Shakespeare wrote for live audiences. His plays were meant to be performed, watched, and heard. *Shakespeare Superstar* can give students an earful of the musical metaphoric language and a hearty look into the magical experience of watching professional actors portraying human beings (and other creatures) interacting in some of the most memorable scenes and moments from the mind of a master dramatist. His iconic characters and themes live within each of us. Their universal ideas and mysteries appeal to different ages and audiences on different levels and from different directions.
